

Special facilities for women

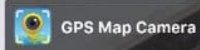
There are special facilities for women in the campus like girls common room, separate gymnasium for girls, hostel, counselling facilities for girls

- (a) **Safety and Security** • Well-trained and vigilant security guards stationed across the campus.
 - Security checkpoints at all campus entries and exits.
 - Extensive surveillance network with 24x7 monitored control rooms.
 - Rotational duty by all faculty members for discipline and security.
- (b) • Strict implementation of Anti-Ragging, Anti-Smoking and Mobile Free Campus. • Awareness campaigns on women safety and gender sensitivity through lectures, street plays and videos. Separate hostels for men and women with dedicated wardens. • The Institute is the preferred destination of parents for education of their female wards as evidenced by the Stakeholder Feedback. separate gyms for male and female students.
- (c) **Counseling** • Formal and informal avenues for counseling male and female students and staff for academic and other issues/problems. Grievance Redressal Committees for staff and students . Faculty Placement Cells and Alumni Placement Assistance Cell • Others – Entrance Exam Counseling, Orientation Programmes for Teachers and Students. Counselling is done by mentors and dept of psychiatry.
- (d) **Common Rooms:** Separate common rooms for girls is present.
