



**REPORT ON TEACHING SESSIONS OF IMMUNIZATION CLINIC**

Each academic year MNRMCH department of paediatrics conducts teaching sessions in the child welfare and immunization clinic. For *undergraduates and interns* the theory of immunization is taught as didactic lectures and its practical application is learnt in the immunization clinic. For *post graduates*, they are posted in the immunization clinic as a part of their curriculum where they not only learn the immunization schedule and the routes of administration of individual vaccine as well as the proper storage and monitoring of these vaccines.

**REPORT ON RELEVANCE AND OPERATIONAL FEATURES OF MNRMCH IMMUNIZATION CLINIC**

The Paediatric dept. Of MNRMCH conducts regular teaching sessions for undergraduate students (II, III & IV year) during theory lectures and as practical sessions during clinical postings. These sessions cover importance of immunization, types of vaccines, methods of immunization, vaccine schedule as part of national immunization programme, vaccine delivery/transport with maintenance of cold chain, storage of vaccine, and routes of vaccine administration, maintenance of vaccination records, post vaccination care and counselling. The Interns and postgraduates are trained similarly during their postings in immunization clinic. The UG and PG students and interns actively participate in the community oriented activities organized by departments of Paediatrics and Community Medicine in spreading awareness on immunization through various awareness programmes organized by MNRMCH. They also take part in national immunization programmes like pulse polio.
