The International Crops Research Institute for the Semi-Arid-Tropics (ICRISAT) is an international research organization headquartered at Patancheru 502 324, Telangana, India with privileges and immunities of the United Nations (Privileges and Immunities) Act, 1947, extended through Extraordinary Gazette Notification No. UI/222(66)/71 dated 28th October 1972, issued by the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India.

ICRISAT has established Agribusiness and Innovation Platform (AIP) that works as a global platform for transfer of technologies to private/ public sector organization and is promoting collaborative activities to achieve ICRISAT mandate and economic development of the region. At AIP-ICRISAT Intellectual Property Facilitation Cell (IPFC) has been established with support from the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME), Government of India which facilitates all IPR related activities including Intellectual Property (IP) protection, IP advisory, and technology transfer.

MNR Foundation for Research & Innovation (MNR-FRI), a Not-for-Profit company under Section 8 of the Indian Companies Act, 2013 having its registered office at MNR Nagar, Narsapur Road, Sangareddy 502294, Telangana. MNR-FRI is working on innovation creation and knowledge dissemination in the region.

ICRISAT and MNR-FRI are hereinafter referred to individually as "Party" or collectively as "Parties".

- 1. ICRISAT and MNR-FRI desire and intend to collaborate and build on the synergy of both parties to identify and nurture grass root innovations at the institutional level and work together to leverage the IP culture at the Institute and in the region. AIP-ICRISAT will be the focal unit representing ICRISAT under this collaboration. The scope of the collaboration is as follows:
  - 1.1. Assistance in development of institutional IP Policy for MNR-FRI.
  - 1.2. Assistance to MNR-FRI in IP identification, drafting and filing of appropriate IP applications and mecessary guidance to protect the innovations being developed at MNR-FRI.
  - 1.3. To pintly explore the opportunities for technology transfer/Commercialization and technology management through appropriate models.
  - To jointly perform due diligence studies to analyze the IP Potential of the innovations and

- MNR-FRI and AIP-ICRISAT will connect their network institutions with each other for support on need basis.
- MNR-FRI and AIP-ICRISAT will engage mutually in knowledge exchange and participation in each other's programs and events.
- The Parties acknowledge that all visits of its staff and related costs will be borne by their own respective Institutions.
- 3. This document is not intended to create legal or binding obligations on either party. It serves only as a record of the parties' current intentions. Before any of the activities set out in this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) are implemented, to ensure the activities can be accomplished in conformity with the law and so as to enable the principles set out in this MoU to be implemented, the parties shall negotiate the arrangements and enter into formal and binding separate definitive agreement or agreements with each other which will detail the specific form and content of the activities, cost sharing, and cover the responsibilities and rights of each Party. Such agreements will be negotiated in good faith.
- 4. The Parties agree that, without prior review and written approval of other Party, neither Party shall issue a press release or otherwise make a public announcement concerning the subject matter of this MoU or make any statements on behalf of or concerning the other Party to press, media, brokers, banks, and/or any other person.
- 5. This MoU commences from the date of last signing and shall be in force for 3 (three) years. The MoU may be terminated at any time by mutual consent or by 3 (three) months' notice by either party. It may be amended, modified, extended, or renewed only on the written consent of both Parties. The Institutions agree to review this MoU six months prior to end of the 3-year term.
- The specific terms of this MoU do not preclude the development of future collaborative ventures or projects not mentioned in this document.

- 1. This memorandum is made for carrying out basic research, medically and socially relevant research.
- 2. Research will be carried out under defined project titles, which will have one PI from respective college of MNRET and one PI and co-PI from IITH
- 3. Projects involving human subjects/samples will commence after Institutional Ethical clearance from respective college of MNRET.
- 4. Intellectual property rights will be decided on individual projects among the partnering institutions. There will be a separate agreement for each project.
- 5. Paper published in International, and national journals, International, investigators, and researchers from both institutes will share national conferences.
- 6. This understanding is valid for a period of three years and will be extended based on mutual understanding.
- 7. Either party agrees to provide three-month advance notice before terminating this memorandum of understanding and all data available from ongoing projects will be shared in a mutually agreeable manner.

MNR-FRI is formed by MNR Educational Trust to facilitate active interaction of clinicians with Academia and Industry for improved healthcare methods and products; establish research programs dealing with regional healthcare challenges of lower socio-economic strata; promote entrepreneurship among students and faculty of science with a special emphasis on MNR Educational Trust members; organize visits of eminent scientists from India and abroad for research seminars and guidance in the areas of medical research and conduct research workshops for research skill development in the fields of molecular biology, etc. and short term exchange programs for MNR Educational Trust members to visit well established research labs to enhance their areas to share research expertise and clinical materials, and provide guidance to MNR Educational Trust members in developing their ideas into tangible products and to support their prototype to product; pursuing and promoting world class academic teaching, scientific research, problem solving through consultancy services to various industries and providing lifelong education and training through its faculties and directorates.

### About WE Hub

The theme at the GES 2017 held in Hyderabad, was "Women First, Prosperity for All" and focused on what can and should be done to foster and promote entrepreneurship among women. Identifying the need for an exclusive platform to support and guide Women Entrepreneurs in their

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entrepreneurial journey, the Government of Telangana announced during the GES, WE Hub,

Women Entrepreneurs Hub.

WE Hub is a state-run platform women entrepreneurs which helps women from diverse

backgrounds by providing a soft - landing hub and mentoring them to be successful in their

entrepreneurial journey. Through WE Hub, we aim to support women entrepreneurs with

innovative ideas, solutions and entities focusing on emerging areas in technology. The mandate

and goal of WE Hub is to eliminate financial, societal and support barriers for women and help

them succeed in their enterprises. In order to fulfil this, we aim to conduct an empirical research

study to understand the nature of the problems faced by women entrepreneurs, and the plausible

interventions.

are entering into a Memorandum of Understanding to jointly work towards understanding &

bettering the ecosystem for Women Entrepreneurs, Girls in STEM, and Women Career

Professionals in Telangana.

This MoU is being entered into by the two parties to set forth the terms and understandings to

achieve the purpose as detailed below -

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### Purpose and scope of the MoU

The purpose and scope of the MoU shall be to jointly foster and promote women-owned or women-led start-ups in the fields of (but not limited to) Healthcare, Medicine, Biosciences, MedTech.

### Roles & Responsibilities of the Parties

### WE Hub

- · WE Hub to connect relevant start-ups to MNR-FRI to facilitate technical support
- In addition, WE Hub will provide the start-up with business advisory support, strategy and roadmap planning, go-to-market strategy, customer acquisition and other ancillary incubations services
- MNR-FRI to facilitate technical support in terms of Ideation, Doctor-patient interaction,
   Evaluation and Validation, Regulatory guidance, Clinical Trials, and technical lab space

### Funding

Unless otherwise specifically agreed to in writing by the Parties, each Party will bear on their own the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MOU. In the event of any consequential financial obligations arising out of any initiative of the parties under this MoU, the parties would take appropriate decision by mutual discussion and understanding through separate document(s) on a case to case basis. In that case, taxes if any will be charged extra and withholding tax if any will be deducted by respective party on any financial transaction as per applicable laws.

### Nature of MoU

This MoU is not a legally binding document and serves only as a guideline of the terms of engagement mutually agreed to between the said partners. The said MoU shall in no form be legally enforceable and has no binding on either party/ partner involved in the same.

### Article 1

- 1. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY, INVENTIONS AND INNOVATIONS
- 1.1 All intellectual property held by either Party to this MoU, prior to entering into this MoU or disclosed or introduced in connection with this MoU and all materials in which such intellectual property is held, disclosed or introduced shall remain the property of the Party introducing or disclosing it.

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All Programme materials that are created, developed by the Parties jointly for the purpose of this MoU shall be owned jointly by both the Parties. Neither of the Parties, shall, while using the Programme Materials in future, represent or declare that the Programme Materials were solely created by it.

1.3 Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as a license or transfer or an obligation to enter into any further agreement with respect to any intellectual property currently licensed to or belonging to either Party.

### Article 2

- 2. REPRESENTATION TO THE PUBLIC AND CONFIDENTIALITY
- 2.1 Neither of the Parties shall use the name or logo of the other for any purpose whether in relation to any advertisement or other form of publicity without obtaining the prior written consent of the other Party.
- 2.2 None of the terms or provisions of this MoU shall be disclosed by either Party without the prior written approval of the other Party, to any person other than the Party's advisors for purposes of assisting such Party in connection with the Programme (provided that the disclosing Party shall ensure that such advisors shall be under an obligation not to disclose the same to any other person) and unless required by any applicable laws and rules to which the disclosing Party may be subject. Notwithstanding the generality of the above, the Parties may notify third parties of the fact that this MoU is in effect.
- 2.3 All information furnished in relation to this MoU by one Party to the other, which is clearly identified as proprietary, sensitive or confidential at the time of disclosure, will be kept confidential by the receiving Party, and will not be disclosed to any third party otherwise than to carry out the provisions of this MoU, unless such disclosure has been agreed in writing between the Parties.
- 2.4 The provisions of this Article will not apply to any information in the public domain; information in the possession of the receiving Party prior to the disclosure of the information; information which is independently developed by the receiving Party;

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information required to be released by law; and information which is rightfully received by receiving Party from third parties without any breach of confidentiality obligations.

2.5 This Article will survive the expiration or termination of this MoU for one (1) year from the date of expiration or termination of this MoU.

### Article 3

- AMENDMENTS
- 3.1 This MoU may be amended and supplemented in writing at any time as decided and agreed by mutual written consent of the Parties.

### Article 4

- 4. TERM AND TERMINATION OF MOU
- 4.1 This MoU shall commence on the Effective Date and shall remain in force for a period of one (1) year or the successful completion of the Programme (the "Term"), whichever is later. After the expiry of the Term, this MoU shall stand terminated. Both the Parties, may enter into similar MoU/Understanding for future collaborations. If either of the Parties wishes to terminate this MoU, the same may be done by way of 30 days' notice.
- 4.2 Either Party may at any time, by way of 2 (two) weeks' notice, intimate to other party, its intent of terminating this MOU.

### Article 5

- GOVERNING LAWS
- 5.1 In respect to its performance in India, this MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India and enforceable in the Courts of Hyderabad, India.

### Article 6

- ARBITRATION
- 6.1 Any dispute or difference between the Parties with regard to this MoU and all related matters whatsoever shall be discussed and settled amicably. In the event of any failure to resolve the disputes or differences amicably within Thirty (30) days, all such disputes or differences whatsoever, shall be referred to arbitration. The arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English and in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Arbitration and

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Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification or enactment thereof. The venue of Arbitration shall be Hyderabad, India. The Parties have agreed that a sole arbitrator shall be appointed mutually by both the Parties. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the Parties

# Memorandum of Understanding

This agreement is made this 07/11/2018 day of 06/11/2019 between MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL and Gengispharma, a public institution of higher education which is a body politic and corporate located at MNR Nagar, Fasalwadi, Narsapur Road, Sangareddy – 502294, Sri. Dr T. Venkat Ramanlah (Principal) MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL, Sejal.B (Director) GENGISPHARMA hereinafter (MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL) and [GENGISPHARMA] located at [38, Block-A, Kukatpally Industrial Estate, Balanagar, Hyderabad, Telangana 500037].

In the spirit of friendship and with mutual interest in cooperation, MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL and GENGISPHARMA enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to promote joint educational and cultural collaboration and agree as follows:

### **ARTICLE 1: SCOPE OF COLLABORATION**

1.1 Areas of collaboration may be proposed by either institution and may include, but are not limited to:

- Joint teaching, research, or cultural activity;

- Staff professional development;
- Sharing or creation of educational materials and resources.

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- 1.2 Any specific activity developed under this MOU shall be detailed in a subsequent agreement, signed by each institution's authorized signatory, which will describe the scope of the proposed activity, intended outcomes, budget, and responsible departments or individuals.
- 1.3 All activities shall be subject to the availability of funds and the approval of each institution's authorized representatives.

### ARTICLE 2: DURATION AND EVALUATION

- 2.1 This MOU shall be in effect for a period of [1] year from the last date of signature. Either party may request termination of this agreement, in writing, ninety (90) days prior to the proposed termination date. Any activities in progress at the time of termination shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- 2.2 A joint evaluation of the MOU will be initiated by the designated representatives six (6) months prior to the expiration date. Following the evaluation, the MOU may be renewed and resigned for an additional One (1) year period.
- 2.3 Amendments to this MOU may be requested, in writing, by either party and approved by the authorized signatories.

### **ARTICLE 3: NON-DISCRIMINATION**

The parties agree not to discriminate on the basis of religion, race, creed, national or ethnic origin, sex, age, handicap, political affiliation, sexual orientation, disability or status as a veteran.

### **ARTICLE 4: COMPLIANCE WITH LAW**

The parties specifically intend to comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations as they may be amended from time to time. If any part of this Agreement is determined to violate federal, state, or local laws, rules, or regulations, the parties agree to negotiate in good faith revisions to any such provisions. If the parties fail to agree within a reasonable time to revisions required to bring the entire Agreement into compliance, either party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party.

### **ARTICLE 5: FORCE MAJEURE**

In the event students are unable to complete the Program due to causes beyond the control of MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL, including, but not limited to: acts of God; war; acts of the government; fires; floods; epidemics; quarantine restrictions; strikes, labour disputes or work stoppages; transportation contingency; and freight embargoes; other catastrophes or any similar occurrences beyond MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL reasonable control, MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL will assist the affected students in finding an alternate site to complete the Program.

### ARTICLE 6: FERPA

The parties acknowledge that information (if any) received from MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL regarding students may be protected by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA"), and agrees to use such information only for the purpose for which it was disclosed and not to make it available to any third party without first obtaining the student's written consent. For the purposes of this Agreement, Home Institution shall be deemed to be a "university official."

### ARTICLE 7: USE OF NAME

None of the parties shall use the name, logo, likeness, trademarks, image or other intellectual property of either of the other parties for any advertising, marketing, endorsement or any other purposes without the specific prior written consent of an authorized representative of the other party as to each such use. Home Institution may refer to the affiliation with MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL in public information materials regarding the relevant Program. MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL reserves the right to review and request modification of Home Institution's reference to MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL as necessary. Home Institution may refer to the affiliation with MNR MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL in its brochures and other public information materials having to do with the

### ARTICLE 8: INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS

Each party is separate and independent and this Agreement shall not be deemed to create a relationship of agency, employment, or partnership between or among them. ### **ARTICLE 9: SEVERABILITY**

The provisions of this Agreement are severable, and if any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect.

### ARTICLE 10: WAIVER

The waiver of any breach of any term of this Agreement does not waive any subsequent breach of that or another term of this Agreement.

### **ARTICLE 11: ASSIGNMENT**

No party may assign this Agreement or any rights or obligations under this Agreement to any person or entity without the prior written consent of the other parties. Any assignment in violation of this provision is null and void.

### **ARTICLE 12: ENTIRE AGREEMENT**

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the parties as to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior discussions, agreements and undertakings of every kind and nature between them, whether written or oral, with respect to such subject matter. This Agreement may subsequently be modified only by a written document executed by both parties.

### **ARTICLE 13: NOTICES**

Any consent, waiver, notice, demand, request or other instrument required or permitted to be given under this Agreement or any related agreements shall be in writing and shall be delivered by hand or sent prepaid telex, cable or facsimile transmission, or sent, postage prepaid, by registered, certified or express mail or reputable overnight courier service and shall be deemed given when so delivered by hand, telexed, cabled or transmitted, or if mailed, five (5) days after the notice is delivered to the courier service, addressed to the addresses set forth herein, or to such other address as may later be PRINCIPAL specified in writing by either party. 




