- Plastic coated paper cups, plastic teacups, plastic tumbler, thermocoal cups
- Plastic carry bag of all sizes and thickness, plastic coated carry bags, non-woven bags.
- Wate pouches / packets / bottles

### POLICY SCOPE

The policy will be applicable for all the teaching staff, non-teaching staff security, students and their parents or guardians.

### PROCEDURE

- To communicate the policy objectives and action plan to staff and students.
- To create awareness of soil degradation and water contamination due to the disposal of plastics
- To clarify and define the plastics that must be avoided inside or outside the campus,
- To encourage the use of steel water bottles rather than plastic
