Feedback Committee Report

A set of questions were given to Students, Teachers, Professionals, Alumni and Employer regarding the current Curricula/syllabi. The questions were formatted to evaluate the potential of the curriculum to develop the overall skill, knowledge, analytic abilities and broadening of thinking and perspective, the relevance of curriculum when real situations are faced, the depth of the content of curriculum, the extent of coverage of the syllabus, clarity deliverance, the effort required to complete the syllabus.

The questions put to Students, Teachers, Professionals, Alumni and Employer were:

1. Learning Value (in terms of skills, knowledge, analytical abilities or broadening perspectives)
2. Applicability / relevance to real life situations
3. Depth of the course content
4. Extent of the coverage of course
5. Clarity and relevance of reading material
6. Extent of effort required by students
7. Relevance / learning value of project / report given to them.

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
Analysis of feedback given by students : Total – 185 responses

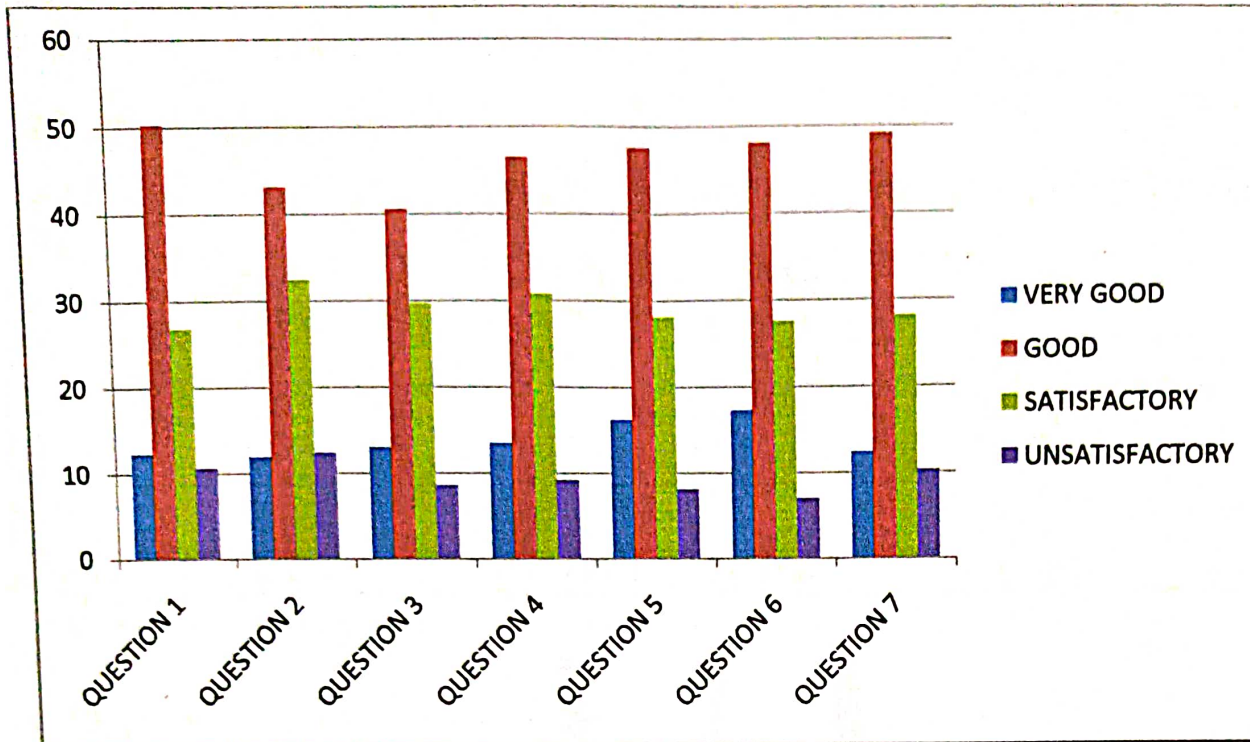

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90.4% of students find the curriculum to be satisfactory/good/very good.

Suggestions by students:

1. The students want the teaching to be clinical cases based teaching/ teaching with specific mention by the teachers of the practical importance of the content/ Simulation based teaching.
2. The students prefer free and fearless communication and interaction with the teachers.
3. Students want the exams to be more MCQs based for it to be more entrance exam oriented and more conceptual focusing questions.
4. Students stressed on rendering of easy reading material like handovers besides their routine reference books for ready understanding.
5. Students feel that more team projects and collective effort presentations would encourage team spirit, coordinated effort in studies and interaction with other students and teachers.
6. Students suggested that the subjects to be taught in depth wherever required rather than just the basics. Teaching should be taught about the new developments in the respective fields and in research . Students feel suffocated in the campus over-disciplined environment and need a free hand to develop innovative thinking and pursue the curriculum in their own method.
7. The library should be updated with new editions, and scientifically thought stimulative books.
8. More faculty should be recruited for more efficient delivery of the curriculum.

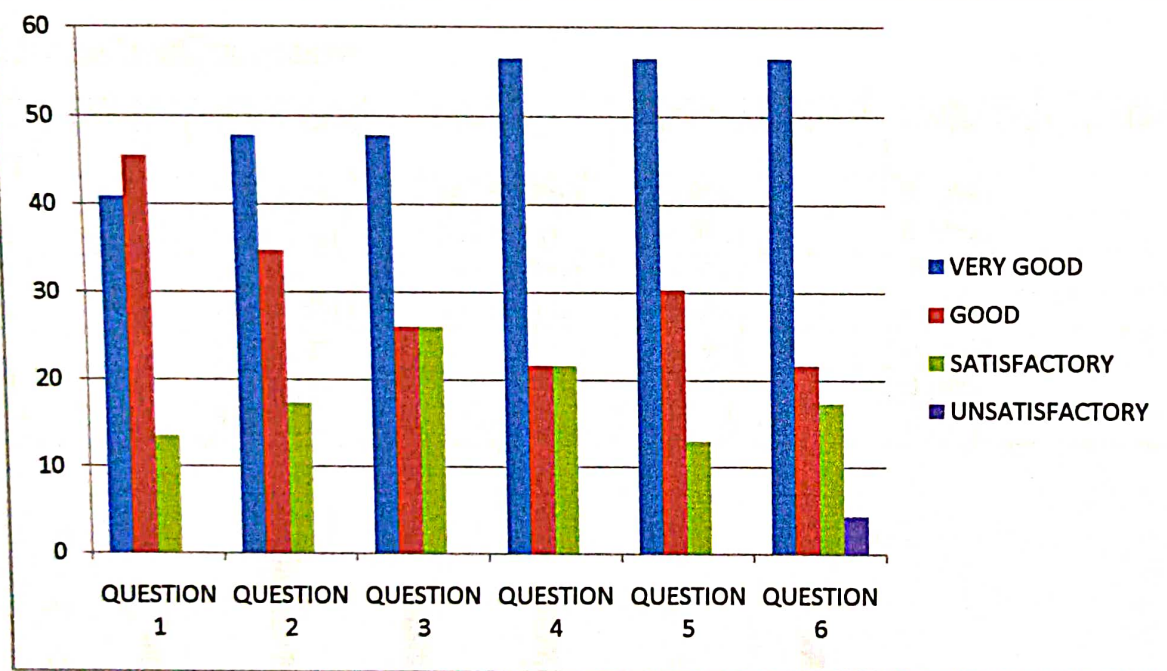
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Analysis of feedback given by Alumni: Total - 23 responses

Suggestions by Alumni:

99% of the Alumni holds the view that the curricula rating is equal to or more than 7 out of 10. The view of the Alumni is:

1. The faculty should contribute to the counseling and help in planning of career of the student.
2. More practical Clinical training is required.

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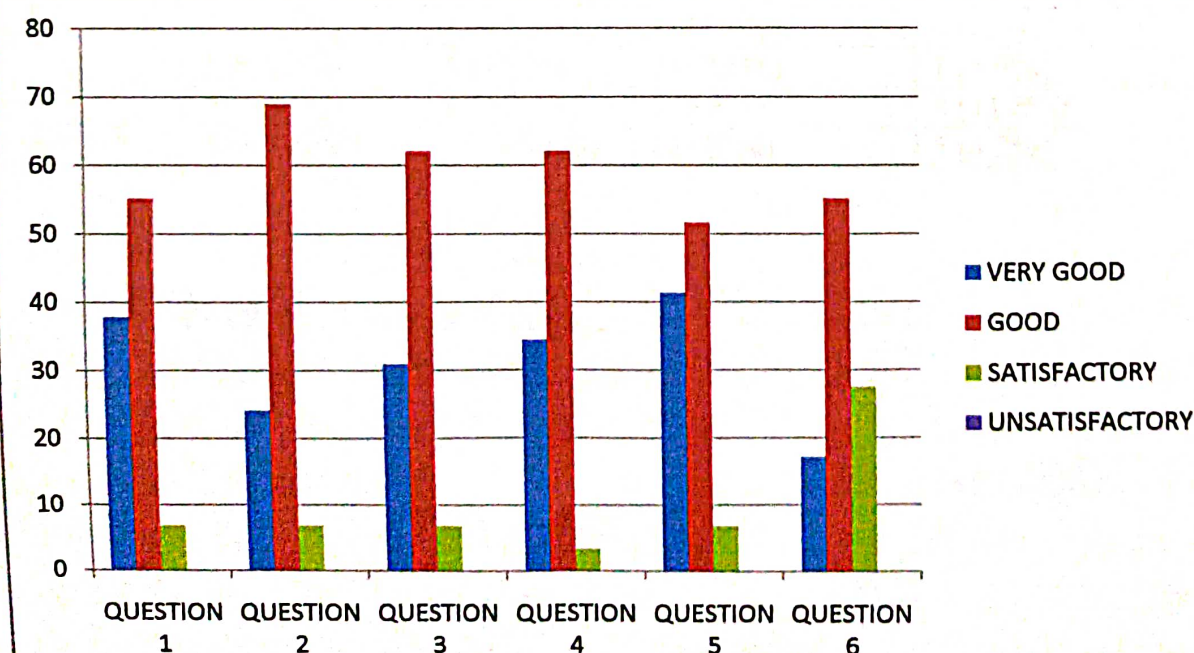
3. Seminars should be conducted every weekends for the UGs to boost up the confidence of the student.
4. Professors should help students to interact with the patients.
5. More focus should be on improving the procedural skills of the students.
6. Teachers should concentrate more on clearing concepts in the subject.
7. The students should be motivated by the teachers from time-to-time.
8. MCQ based exams should also be introduced.
9. After completion of syllabus, freedom should be given to students to prepare in their own way.
10. Cultural and sports activities should be organized along the weekly seminars for better development of personality of the students.

Suggestions by Staff:

The overall rating given by the Staff is equal to or more than 7 out of 10. The staff feels that to improve the outcome:


1. More time is required for revision of the syllabus. For this, the curriculum should focus more on the common diseases prevalent in the community and less on the less common diseases.
2. Only basics should be taught to MBBS Doctors so that the whole syllabus is effectively delivered to the students.
3. More interaction and discussions between the teachers and the students and guided interaction between students can help them to better cope with the curriculum.
4. Innovative and interesting ways should be taken up by the teachers to gain the attention of the students.

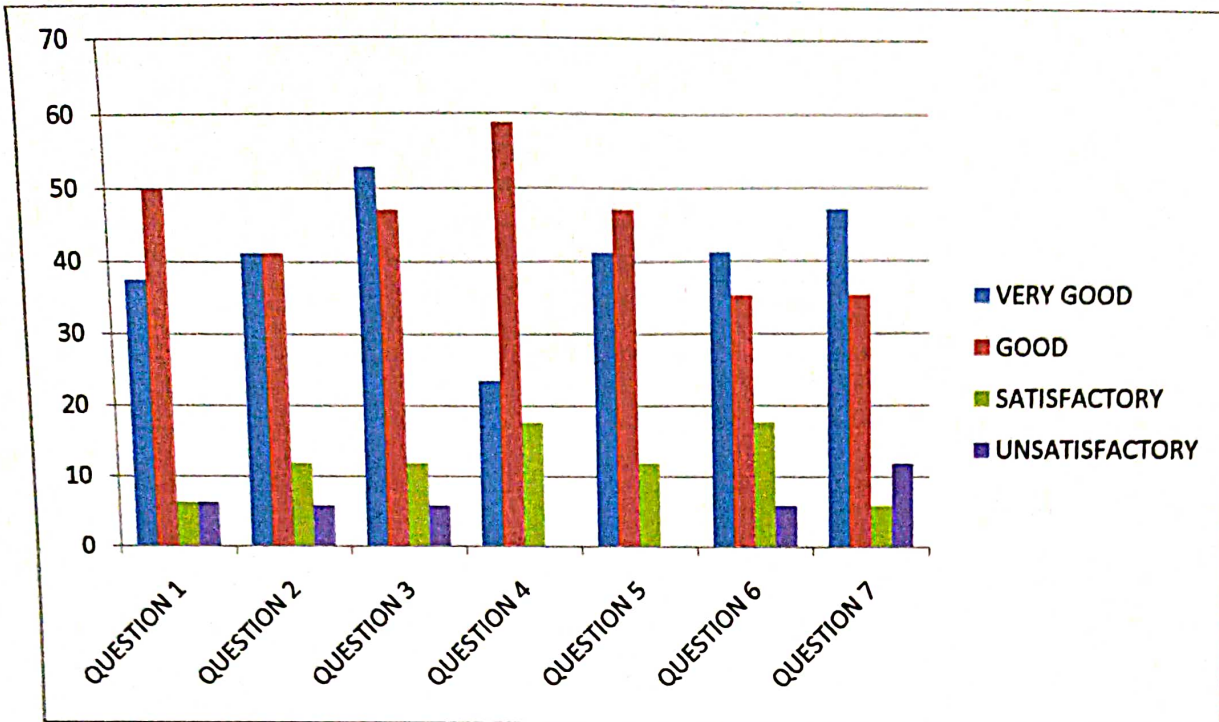

Suggestions by Professionals:


1. 100% of professionals agree to the extent of coverage of syllabus. More than 80% consider the curriculum good/very good. Suggestions given by Professionals given are:
2. More faculty required as the assessment of students has become more fine.
3. More revision and practice is required to make the students more skilled.
4. Assessment should be open ended.
5. The syllabus should be more to the point depending on the needs of the community.
6. More resources should be made available to the students.

Feedback by employer

The responses to all the questions are Good/Very good.

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The overall rating for the curriculum given by all categories (i.e. students, alumni, staff, professionals and employer) is 96.94%.


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
