

4. In pursuance of the above notification M/s. M.N.R. Educational Trust, Kukatpally, Hyderabad, has made an application to Justice S.V. Maruthi Committee for grant of Essentiality Certificate for establishment of Medical College with 100 (one hundred) admissions at Sangareddy, Medak District. Justice S.V. Maruthi Committee have visited the proposed Medical College at Sangareddy, Medak District to be established by M/s. M.N.R. Educational Trust, Hyderabad on 20.02.2000 along with other members of the Committee. After detailed inspection, Justice S.V. Maruthi Committee have recommended for grant of Essentiality Certificate in favour of M/s. M.N.R. Educational Trust, for establishment of Medical College at Sangareddy, Medak District with an intake capacity of 100 (one hundred) admissions per academic year.

5. The Government after careful examination of the above recommendations of Justice S.V. Maruthi Committee, hereby issue an Essentiality Certificate to M/s. M.N.R. Educational Trust, Hyderabad, for establishment of Medical College at Sangareddy, Medak District, with an intake capacity of 100 admissions per academic year subject to the following conditions namely:-

1. that M/s. M.N.R. Educational Trust, Hyderabad should abide by the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 as amended, from time to time and the regulations framed thereunder for establishment of new Medical College;
2. that before applying for permission to establish a new Medical College by M/s. M.N.R. Educational Trust, at Sangareddy, Medak District, the said Trust shall ensure the conditions laid down in the scheme relating to Medical Colleges referred to in clauses (a) and (b) of Sub-Section (2) of Section 10-A of the IMC Act, 1956 as amended from time to time as annexed to a Regulation 2 of the regulations relating to the establishment of new Medical Colleges made by the Medical Council of India are fulfilled.
3. If ultimately, the Government of India, Medical Council of India grant permission for establishment of a new Medical College by the said Trust, the admission of students into the college and the fee structure should be in accordance with the rules and regulations or any executive orders issued or to be issued by the State or Central Government or University of Health Sciences from time to time
4. that the Essentiality Certificate now issued shall however subject to the final result of G.A. Nos. 1326/99 and batch which are pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh regarding validity of Justice S.V. Maruthi Committee.
