The question of establishment of new Medical Colleges in the State is under consideration of Covernment since some time past. In the G.O. first road above, the Coveryment have decided to allow for establishment of five Medical Colleges in Private Sector at the following places :-

- 1. Nizamabad. 2. Mahabubhagar. 3. Bellampalli (Adilabad District)
- 4. Hellore and 5. Eluru (West Godavari District).

The Government have also constituted a Committee under the Chairmanship of Justice S.V. Maruthi for scrutiny and recommending the applications to Government for issue of Essentiality Certificate for establishment of Medical College in the above locations.

- 2. In the reference 3rd read above, the Government have decided to allow for establishment of three more Medical Colleges at the fellowing places !..
  - 1. Erikakulam
  - 2. Sanga Heddy (Modak District)
  - 3. Cuddapali.
- 3. In the reference 4th read above, the Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad who is the Nember Convenor of the Justice S.V. Maruthi Committee has insued a Motification inviting applications for grant of Essentiality Certificates for establishment of Medical Colleges in the locations indicated in Para (2) above.

- 4.' In pursuance of the above notification M/s. M.N.A. Educational Trust, Kukatpally, Nyderabad, has made an application to Justice S.V. Maruthi Committee for grant of Essentiality Certificate for establish ment of Medical College with 100 (one hundred) admissions at San areddy, Medak District. Justice S.V. Maruthi Committee have visited the proposed Medical College at Sangareddy, Medak District to be established by M.S. M.N.R. Educational Trust, Hyderabad on 20.02.2000 along with other members of the Committee: After detailed inspection, Justice S.V. Maruthi Committee have recommended for grant of Essentiality Certificate in favour of M/s.M.N.R. Educational Trust, for establishment of Medical College at Sanga Neddy, Medak District with an intake capacity of 100 (one hundred) admissions per academic year.
- 5. The Government ofter careful examination of the above recommendations of Justice S.V. maruthi Committee, hereby issue an Essentiality Certificate to M/s. M.M. Educational Trust, Hyderabad, for establishment of Medical College at Sanna Meddy, Modak District, with an intake capacity of 100 admissions per academic year subject to the following conditions namely!
- that M/s. M.u. N. Educational Trust, Hyderabad should abide by the indian Medical Council Act, 1956 as amended, from time to time and the regulations framed thereunder for establishmen of new Medical College;
- that before applying for permission to establish a new Medical College by M/s. M.N.N. Educational Trust, at Sanga Heddy, Medak District, the said Trust shall ensure the conditions laid down in the scheme relating to Medical Colleges referred to in clauses (a) and (b) of Sub-Section (2) of Section 10-A of the IMC Act, 1956 as amended from time to time as annexed to a liggulation 2 of the regulations relating to the establishment of new Medical Colleges made by the Medical Council of India are fulfilled.
- If ultimately, the Government of India, Medical Council of India grant permission for establishment of a new Medical College by the said Trust, the admission of students into the college and the fee structure should be in accordance with the rules and regulations or any executive orders issued or to be issued by the State or Central Government or University of Health Sciences from time to time
- 4. that the Essentiality Cartificate now issued shall however subject to the final result of 1.1.A.Nos.1326.99 and batch which are pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh regarding validity of Justice S.V. Maruthi Committee.
